

Top 10 Tips

for a Successful Winter Special Checklist



Follow these tips to save money and ensure regulatory compliance:

1 Contact us for a quote and Return Material Authorization Form.

2 Make sure the gauge shutter is fully closed and leak test is valid.

3 Make sure case is labelled correctly.

4 Inspect your case for cracks—if it's damaged/cracked, it can't be used for transport.

5 Complete and include your transfer document—save a copy of your records.

6 DO NOT remove standard block—to reduce weight, remove scraper plate, drill rod, extraction tool & hammers.

7 Wipe up any moisture inside the case and tip out any dirt.

8 Make sure you include the keys for the case and trigger lock.

9 Complete and include the Return Materials Authorization Form.

10 Be sure to describe any issues/concerns with your gauge.
